The Clinical Trial Experience is directly applicable to

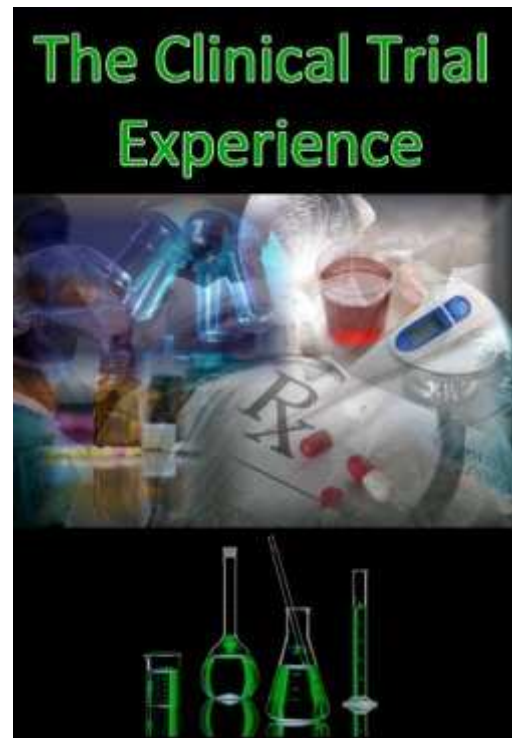
- The science curriculum at Key Stage 3, 4 & 5
